Please review with your child. You must explain the directive and the importance of following rules for the safety of all students and staff and to ensure a very productive school year.

On behalf of our entire staff, we welcome you and look forward to a fantastic School year.

We use a positive and proactive approach to discipline. We emphasize learning Life skills and making positive choices. We recognize good behaviors regularly and teach school-wide procedures consistently. This will help to decrease problem behaviors and discipline referrals.

- Team Spirit: Students and staff work as a team to assist one another to achieve excellence. We strive to inspire this "team spirit" in every student and to benefit from the diverse approaches, creativity, and talents that different students and teachers bring to the learning process.
- Student Lunch & Snacks: Parents must send lunch or snacks with their students.
- Students are prohibited from eating or drinking in the classroom. Gum and candy are also prohibited. Students will be subject to progressive discipline for this behavior.

D. POLICIES & GENERAL INFORMATION

General Procedure:

- Show a Positive Attitude, focus on learning, and Show effort in all tasks.
- Accept Responsibility, Be friendly, and helpful, and Treat others Kindly.
- Come prepared for learning, Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- Take ownership of your actions, Work Together, and Choose kind words and actions.
- Show Respect, Listen and follow directions, think before you speak, and act.

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Restroom Procedure:

- Be quick, quiet, and careful, Flush when finished, wash hands with soap, and preferably wduu, throw used paper towels in the trash.

Lunch Procedure:

- Go to a table and stay seated until dismissed, Talk quietly with friends around you. Raise your hand if something is needed.
- When dismissed, clean your area, and throw away trash.

Classroom Procedure:

- Any activity that might cause injury to self or others is not permitted, equipment brought from home must be approved by your teacher or program director.

E. ATTENDANCE/ TARDINESS:

- Attendance: Regular attendance is mandatory. Students are expected to attend school regularly. The parents and the student are responsible for reaching out to teachers inquiring about assignments and makeup work, missed homework, quizzes, and/or tests when a student is absent.
- Tardiness: Students must arrive at school Before 10:00 A.M. Time management is a vital skill to learn if a student is to succeed academically and professionally. We call on all parents to arrive at school on time to ensure the full benefits of our programs. Students arriving late will not be permitted inside the class until the second period.
- Parents will be contacted for repeated tardiness.
- **Early Dismissal:** A written signed note by the parent or guardian is required for early dismissal.
- In case a student falls sick during school hours, parents or guardians on record will be contacted on the emergency contact phone number given at the time of registration. The parent/Guardian must pick up the child as soon as possible upon receipt of the call.
 - **In case of an emergency, 911 will be contacted.**
 - Parents are strongly advised not to send their child to school if not feeling well, Please Keep your child home if symptoms like fever, cough, sore throat, an upset stomach, etc.

SCHOOL CLOSURES (WEATHER):

- In case of inclement/severe weather conditions: the administration team will make announcements regarding the closure of Sunday school via telephone, text, and e-mail.

DRESS CODE:

- All students and staff of the school are required to dress modestly and decently, upholding personal dignity according to practices of the Islamic faith.

→ Students must abide by the school's dress code.

Boys Full or Half-sleeve shirts and bottoms covering their knees. No shorts and no backward caps.

Girls Loose fitting, full-length garments and a scarf covering the head adequately, No body piercing.

→ Students are encouraged to wear clothing appropriate for learning and moving.

F. HEALTH and SAFETY:

Safety responsibility is shared between parents, students, and the school.

- Parents and students must follow instructions of Parking traffic coordinators and/or crossing guards.
- Students must remain in the school building during school hours unless specifically permitted to do so and accompanied by teacher/adult volunteer(s).
- Please inform the school Administration if your child has any allergies or sickness requiring additional attention from the teacher.
- If a student has any special medical needs and could require medication to be administered (for asthma, allergies, etc...), parents are required to be available on campus.

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Parents' Presence:

Parents are not allowed inside the school, or the Islamic Center, while school is in session. NO EXCEPTIONS (except for medical conditions or allowed by the teacher for education requirements).

Parents roaming the school while classes are in session send the wrong message about the seriousness of our school in the eyes of students.

G. Code of Conduct:

- Students and teachers are in the school for one basic purpose: To promote the Islamic and educational development of students, to accomplish this goal, each student is expected to meet the following disciplinary objectives:
 - a. Teachers can deduct points for assignments handed in late, homework and assignments must be satisfactory and handed in on time.
 - b. The parent and student are responsible for contacting teachers about assignments and make-up work when a student is absent.
 - c. School Supplies (List Below): Students must come prepared to school. Coming to school without supplies gives them the impression that they are passive participants, and they are here just to pass the time.
 - d. It is a top priority to tutor our students proper Islamic and civil behavior, students exhibiting negative behavior will receive a consequence.
 - e. We model respect to our students, the expectation is that respect is reciprocal, and all students are expected to be respectful and courteous, disrespect for staff or students will not be tolerated and will result in profound consequences.
 - f. Horseplay is not allowed in our school, this includes playing, fighting, pushing, shoving, throwing objects, or any behavior that disrupts the regular school day. Violators will be suspended from school.
 - g. Reasonable Requests: Staff has the authority to direct students' behavior. Students are required to respond appropriately to any reasonable request given by a staff member. Students who fail to appropriately respond will be subject to discipline and/or suspension.
 - h. Students are not permitted to bring electronic games, toys, personal electronic devices, etc. to school. Violators will have devices taken away and returned to their parents at the end of the day.
 - i. School Property: Students must respect the school's and others' property and equipment. Damage of any kind must be reported immediately to the

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teacher or the director. In the case of willful damage or negligence, the student/Parent will expect to contribute part or all the cost of repair.

Failure to uphold the disciplinary objectives may result in the following sequence of events:

1. Name recorded.
2. Referred to the principal.
3. No recess privilege (for the older students).
4. Parents are contacted.
5. Dismissal from school

H. REVISION OF SCHOOL POLICIES:

Sunday School Administration may issue periodic bulletins to announce revisions in the school policies when necessary. These bulletins will be kept on file with the principal and will be emailed and shared on the WhatsApp parent group displayed on the bulletin board.

The current policy on the topics discussed in this school rules & procedures will continue to be enforced.

This is not all-inclusive- Administrators will use their discretion in deciding what disrupts the educational environment.
